

PROFESSIONAL STAFF RESIGNATION

Our mission of educating students as effectively as possible requires qualified, competent and caring employees who honor their commitments and employment contracts. Resignations during the summer and the school year can be very disruptive and detrimental; therefore, the board entreats each employee only to sign a contract if he or she fully expects to fulfill it.

Any member of the faculty wishing to resign shall give at least a four-week written notice to the superintendent. Anyone who resigns after July 1st shall be expected to teach in the next academic year until the superintendent has found a qualified and acceptable replacement.

The board recognizes that extenuating circumstances may arise during a school year necessitating special consideration of a resignation, and will review each case on its individual merits.
