

SCHOOL PHYSICIAN SERVICES

The board may appoint one or more school physicians to function in the school health program. A school physician shall be legally qualified to practice medicine and currently licensed to practice in New Hampshire. A school physician is a recognized school volunteer.

A school physician shall provide advice and consultation with regards to the development of health related curriculum or procedures. A school physician may be asked by the principal to examine students who may be found to need further examination, subject to parental approval. A school physician may also be asked by the principal to examine school employees. Except in certain emergency situations, a school physician is not expected to provide medical care to students or employees.
