

## **USE OF STUDENTS IN PUBLIC INFORMATION PROGRAM**

We believe that the public schools have the primary responsibility for the formal education of the children and youth of the community. However, the Board recognizes that many governmental agencies and community organizations, while not primarily concerned with education, play a definite role in education.

Therefore, it will be the desire of the Board to establish positive working relationships with all other public and community organizations which contribute to the education process and to the general welfare of the citizens of the community.

### Distribution of Notices

- A. Notices may be distributed for public and community organization via students provided that:
- B. It is clearly stated on the notice that the function being advertised is not a school-sponsored activity when that is the case.
- C. All preparation of notices has been completed by the sending agency.
- D. The classroom management of such notices does not place an unreasonable administrative burden on school personnel.
- E. The approval of the Superintendent has been obtained.

The participation of pupils in interpreting the educational program of the schools to the community shall be encouraged, with the understanding that –

- 1. Pupils shall not be exploited for the benefit of any individual or group.
- 2. Pupils shall participate only in appropriate situations as determined by the building administrator.
- 3. The use of pupils shall always be evaluated in terms of the effect on the child.
