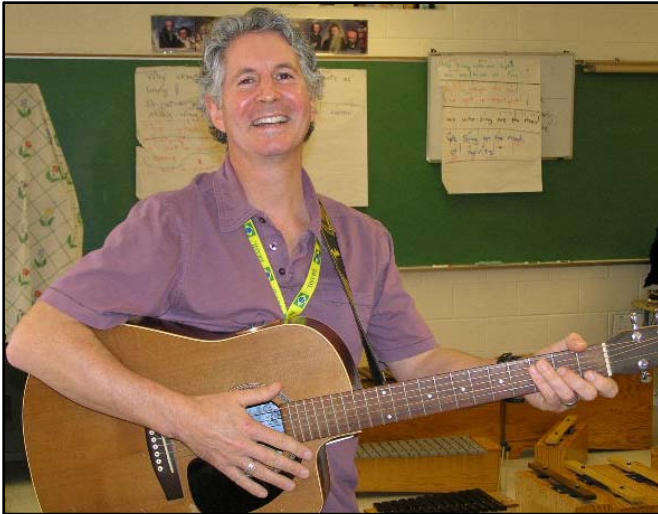


Robert Allwarden—Music Educator
